Classroom Catch-up

Hedgehog Class



Hedgehogs have been very busy with their learning this week. We have been finding out fascinating facts about hibernating animals. We imagined what it would be like to hibernate for the winter and wrote a list of what we would need.

In Science we listened to the story of Funnybones by Alan Ahlberg and made a human skeleton. We learnt the names of the bones and made 'glow in the dark' skeletons for Hallowe'en.

Squirrel Class



Squirrel class have been using their Wassily Kandinsky sketches to create an original Kandinsky painting. The have been looking at the colours he uses, the shapes and lines he creates and how he adds depth to his pictures in the way his ideas cross over and merge with one another. The children have been thinking about their emotions when painting

and reflecting this in the colours they chose.

Squirrel class have been looking at how the Romans conquered Britain and their fight against the Barbarians led by a fearless leader called Boudicca. We have been learning about the food they ate, the clothes they wore and the reasons why the Romans wanted to invade Britain in the first place.

Badger Class



Our Badgers have been working really hard to complete their Anglo-Saxon settlement models. They have spent the past few weeks building them and putting together the finishing touches, including crops, farm animals, water supplies and fencing. Some even have detachable roofs, allowing you to view the internal set-up of an Anglo-Saxon



home.

All of the children have really used their imagination and creativity, in order to finish these fantastic pieces of art!
