Dear Parents/Carers,

I cannot believe, there are only 3 weeks of the autumn term left. It feels like in the blink of an eye, our new wonderful reception class started and all the other classes had just returned from the summer break.

Before I praise our amazing Badger Class, for their triumphant residential trip to Kilve Court, I just need to make you aware of our updated policies and expectations in regards to online safety, device use and safeguarding procedures in and out of the school, setting. This year, the keeping children safe in education document 2023 Keeping children safe in education - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk) was updated with an emphasis on online safety and how it must be monitored and incorporate a higher level of parental awareness and school monitoring, via the senior leadership team and school Governors. For ease, here is a link Policies – Churchstanton Primary School to our updated safeguarding policy and computing and acceptable use policy. Both documents reflect these changes. As part of these policies we will be asking all staff, pupils and parents to sign and acknowledge online safety and device use protocols and procedures in line with current updates and best practice. Part of this signing will also link to social media and messaging platforms outside of school. Information on how and which documents to sign will follow in due course via the school office.

In school as I'm sure you are very aware, we have ICT filtering systems that are regularly monitored by myself and overseen by school Governors to ensure paramount safety for our children and staff in school. I also have conducted a number of assemblies on PEGI ratings (Pan-European Game Information), to make children more aware of potential dangers and the age appropriate platforms, they should and shouldn't be using at home. I have attached a document to this effect highlighting these areas. If you have any doubts in this area and would like further information, please get in touch via the school office. As you will appreciate in this day and age we cannot be careful enough, so alerts and prevention of potential harmful situations in this area at home are paramount and should be reported to school if you are concerned so we can advise and provide guidance.

Safeguarding: We take child protection extremely seriously at our school and this is especially important during any school closure. If you have any concerns you can ring Children






