Dear Parents.

I am writing to clarify and detail the school's expectation on uniform. We have a smart uniform that children are proud of wearing and this inspires strong working relationships, equality and pride. The majority of children wear their uniform correctly and adhere to the rules for uniform, thus avoiding any problems during the school day. To prevent future issues, please can parents/carers help us maintain the standard of uniform and ensure that new items of uniform are bought and comply with our standards. Children will be asked to wear spare uniform if the correct attire is not worn, this also applies to PE kit. If you are having any issues with acquiring the correct uniform or PE kit, please contact the school.

Children are expected to wear:

Uniform List:

- White shirt / polo shirt
- Navy School sweatshirt/cardigan (available from Taunton Uniform Shop)
- Black or grey trousers / shorts
- Black shoes (Trainers are not permitted)
- Navy School sweatshirt / cardigan (available from Taunton Uniform Shop)
- Black or grey skirt just above the knee / pinafore dress
- Blue & white checked dress (Summer)
- Black shoes (Trainers / heels / wedges / fashion boots are not permitted)
- White, grey or black socks or tights.

Boys and girls long hair to be tied back without bows / fashion clips etc and fringes to be kept out of the face. Jewellery is **not** permitted – Earring studs only (to be removed/covered up during PE)

PE Kit:

Navy or black shorts
White round neck t-shirt (available from Taunton Uniform Shop)
Black daps / trainers
Navy jogging bottoms & plain navy hoody for outdoor PE-without logos.
Spare set of pants & socks (KS1)

Forest School:

Due to the nature of Forest School we ask that children wear long trousers (lightweight cotton trousers are ideal – No jeans or shorts please), a long-sleeved t-shirt, a waterproof jacket and Wellington boots. During the winter months a pair of waterproof trousers is essential.
